



Sheet Metal Workers



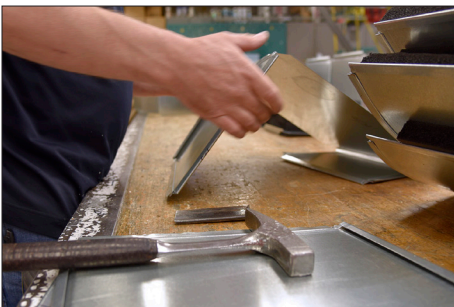
Sheet metal workers repair, replace, and maintain metal work on campus, including heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system components, architectural elements, and other items.

HVAC Services

- Fabricate and repair ventilation ductwork
- Balance supply, return, and exhaust fans
- Adjust dampers to control air flow to registers
- Install and repair fume hoods and fans
- Insulate A/C units with interior duct board covers

Sheet metal workers create architectural elements such as:

- Gutters and downspouts
- Flashing, coping, fascia, soffit, and ridge caps
- Wall paneling
- Chimney caps



Sheet metal workers perform custom fabrication to create specialty metal items; build and install window security screens; and remove, replace, or repair metal pan ceilings.

They also repair miscellaneous items: restroom toilet partitions, lockers, shelving, file cabinets, kitchen equipment, animal cages, corner guards, metal chairs, stands, and electrical boxes.
