

TMT-1: Drawing Searching 101

1. Find your **building number** and year built.
<J:\02 Active Projects\0000 Project Lists\Beths Building List - live.xlsm>
2. Find your **Building Additions Cheat Sheet**.
Open the J drive folder and go to your building number.
Look at the top level for a building addition cheat sheet (not one for every building).
What section of the building are you in? Don't look for anything older than that.
<J:\03 Buildings>
3. Open the **building drawing index**.
<J:\03 Buildings\0000 Drawing Index\Drawings.xlsx>
4. **Filter** for your building number
(search, don't scroll down, or you'll miss drawings that cover multiple buildings)
5. **Find applicable projects**, either:
 - a. Browse through the projects (use Project Name) column for an applicable project, and check the appropriate drawing sheets to see if it covers your area.
 - b. Search for unique keywords (like a room number or "elevator")
6. Click on the links to **view the drawings**.
7. Need to send several drawings to someone?
Go into the "back door" to select multiple files – use columns R and S to locate your drawings.
 - a. Filed by stick – old method
 - b. Filed by project – new method

TIPS

- Indexes and J drive are read only – you can't break them!
- Work completed in the past few years could be "stuck" in J drive "02_Active_Projects" because we didn't get record documents.
- Sometimes building equipment is installed with utility distribution projects – check the "Infrastructure Index" (column C can limit by building, but this field is NOT fully populated – also search by building name and previous names – see #1 above for previous names):

- "Empty/basic" floor plans:
